Communication and Language

We will develop good listening skills and talk in front of a small group, sharing our ideas and experiences.

We will enjoy reciting Nursery Rhymes, discussing new vocabulary and sequencing events.



Phonics To learn Phase 2 sounds: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, s, ss, h, b, f, ff, l, ll. We will be able to use these sounds to sound out and blend cvc words using robot arms e.g. dog (d-o-g). We will play rhyming games and identify the initial sounds in words.



Reading To read harder to read and spell words: I, the, no, put, of, is, to, go, into, pull, as, his. We will independently look at books, hold them the correct way and turn pages.

Writing We will give meaning to marks as we draw and paint, know how to write taught letters and begin to write our own name.

Mathematics

We will be learning to subitise within 3 and represent numbers to 3 in different ways.

We will explore the rules of counting to help us count objects, sounds and actions accurately and compare 2 sets of objects saying which is 'more than' and 'fewer than'. We will identify the composition of 3 and 4 and begin to use language to compare the size of objects.

Physical Development - Gross and Fine Motor

We will make and draw patterns using large scale movements. We will travel in different ways, negotiating space.

We will begin to use a tripod grip when using mark making tools (NIP FLIP GRIP) and know how to use tools safely e.g. scissors for cutting.

Creative Development

We will create pictures of people and faces using different techniques e.g. collage, natural objects. We will look closely at the features of our face and paint self-portraits using lines and shapes. We will draw simple representations of people.

In our play, we will explore a range of materials to create our own models and retell narratives and familiar experiences in our imaginative play.
